Dear Clyde-Savannah parents/guardians,

I hope you enjoyed the hot dry summer of 2020. It is hard to believe that August is here and school resumes in a few weeks. I would like to welcome all the new families to our community and provide everyone with an update on the changes within our school. As you are aware, many changes are being implemented for the upcoming school year due to Covid-19. Some of the changes are reflected below:

- Students will be required to wear masks
- Students will required to remain socially distanced at all times

The high school will be following a hybrid format schedule which means students will be in school one day learning in person (Core subjects) and the next day they will be home learning virtually (mainly electives). This information will be available on each child's schedule. School for all high school students begins on Wednesday, September 9. Students that attend on "A" days will begin their classes in person on September 9. Students that attend "B" days will begin their online classes on September 9. Students are required to attend their online courses and will need to log into google classroom daily. More information on technology distribution to students will be forthcoming on the district website.

The district also has more specific information regarding the re-opening plan on the school website. All parents and students are encouraged to review the document.

It is also important to mention that the school district adopted a new cell phone policy (BOE policy 7316). Since all high school students have access to chrome books, the new policy permits students to use their phones during non-instructional periods only.

As always, my door is open so please let me know any areas of concern that you have with your child or the school. It is important that we do not let any concerns linger, as


