COVID-19 Guidance Pertaining to Interscholastic Athletics as of August 20, 2021:

***As of right now***, fall sports will begin as planned in the Clyde-Savannah Central School District. Below are the guidelines pertaining to COVID-19 safety as we move forward into the fall season.

Indoor Sports:

- Masking will be required of all athletes, spectators, and coaches when indoors.
- There are no capacity limitations with respect to spectators, but social distancing at events is encouraged.

Outdoor Sports:

- Masking is required of all athletes, spectators, and coaches while on the sidelines during contests.
- Masking for student-athletes is encouraged during practice sessions.
- As with indoor sports, there are no capacity limitations with respect to spectators, but social distancing at events is encouraged.

Locker Rooms/Field House:

- Student-athletes, coaches, spectators, and field house volunteers are required to wear masks while in the locker room and field house facilities.

Testing Protocols:

- Clyde-Savannah Central School District ***will be*** implementing a COVID-19 screen testing policy as the season progresses.

Vaccination:

- Student-athletes are highly encouraged to receive their COVID-19 vaccination.
- Masking is required both indoors and outdoors (on the sidelines) regardless of vaccination status.
