

Current Clyde-Savannah Eligibility Policy

Students who are deemed ineligible are ineligible to participate in extracurricular activities and ineligible to attend any school events. They are permitted to attend practices.

FAILING 2 CLASSES

- **When an eligibility report is pulled (2022-2023 dates below), a student who is failing (2) classes for the first time is placed on probation and is still ELIGIBLE to participate.**
- **When an eligibility report is pulled, a student who is failing (2) classes for the second time in a row is deemed ineligible for a 2-week period.**

FAILING 3 OR MORE CLASSES

- **When an eligibility report is pulled, a student who is failing (3) or more classes is deemed ineligible for a 2-week period.**

RETURNING TO ELIGIBILITY

- **After (2) weeks or after the next eligibility report is pulled, a student that has been deemed ineligible (AND SERVED THE INELIGIBILITY PERIOD) can return to being eligible if they are failing (1) or less classes.**

INELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

PROCEDURES: At the end of the third week of school, and every two weeks thereafter, an eligibility report is generated through School Tool. Teachers will indicate students with failing grades and/or incomplete at that point in the quarter. Failure is considered below a 65% in a class. The consequences for a failing grade(s) are as follows:

One failure - the student will be informed and warned. Parents will be notified in writing.

Two failures - the student is placed on probation for a two-week period. During that period, he/she must bring courses to a passing level. If the student continues to fail two courses after the two-week probationary period, he/she will become ineligible for a two-week period. Ineligibility will continue beyond this time if the student continues to fail two or more subjects. However, if a student on probation is failing only one subject at the end of a probationary period, he/she will revert to warning status. Parents will be notified in writing. A student cannot serve consecutive probation periods, i.e., failing two different courses in consecutive periods. A student failing two different courses in consecutive periods will be considered ineligible until he/she has brought grades for each failed course to a passing level.

Three or more failures - automatic ineligibility for two weeks. The period of ineligibility will continue beyond the two weeks until failing grades are brought up to a passing level. An ineligible student who improves performance such that the student is failing only one subject will be placed under warnings and will become eligible to participate. Parents/Guardians will be notified in writing.

The eligibility period begins on Monday morning following the submission of the grade reports.
